Read each passage intentionally. In the third column, describe what progression you observe from one passage to the next.

Passage	Truth Revealed	What Progression Do You Observe?
Ezekiel 28:15	Perfect until iniquity found in him	Sin originates within a created being who was originally blameless.
Ezekiel 28:17	Pride corrupted wisdom	The inward sin develops into pride, corrupting character and judgment.
Isaiah 14:13-14	Self-exaltation openly declared	Pride moves from the heart to open rebellion as Satan seeks God's place.
Isaiah 14:15	Judgment pronounced	God immediately responds to rebellion with righteous judgment.
1 Timothy 3:6	Pride leads to condemnation	Satan's fall becomes a warning that pride brings condemnation to all who follow the same path.
John 8:44	Satan associated with lies and murder	Having fallen, Satan's character is now expressed through deception and destruction of others.
Revelation 12:9	Satan identified as deceiver and adversary	His rebellion reaches its full expression as the continual enemy and deceiver of the whole world.
